OUR VENUE

Our unique facility is located one block from the Lechmere T-station on the Green Line in an historic building featuring a theater (53'x 38') that accommodates up to 120 seated patrons (depending upon stage and seating configuration), with no obstructions.

- non-fixed seating that accommodates a variety of performance configurations
- portable, sprung, roscoe dance floor (22' x 32') with reversible (black and white) marley
- two semi-private bathrooms with lockers and showers
- a private dressing room adjacent to the theater
- professional 24-channel sound system
- professional 24-channel lighting system
- air conditioning and heating throughout
- two fine art gallery spaces available for receptions
- cafe-style tables available for rental
- kawai baby grand piano (\$100 tuning fee)

PROPOSALS

We are actively encouraging proposals for both one-time and multiple performances. Proposals will be considered for **2011-2012** performance dates on a rolling basis.

With your proposal, please include:

- statement of purpose
- artist or organizational resume or biography
- examples of work (photos, dvds, links to online photos or clips, etc.)

PERFORMANCE FEES

If accepted as a Destination Dance Performance, our basic fees are:

- \$600*† per performance
 - \$400* for installation and strike of dance floor with marley, risers and seating included
- *events held on saturday after 4pm and all day sunday will incur a \$33/hour charge for a required security guard
†to secure your performance date(s) there is a 25% deposit required. Amount is based on total number of performances/hours

Performance Fees Include:

Facility Use

- our facility is made available to you for a 6-hour rental period—per performance
- assistance of one production staff member on site for the duration of the rental period
- use of our lighting and sound systems is available, provided you work with an approved technician (fees may apply for the hiring of additional staff at the rate of \$25/hr)
- up to 8 hours of week-of-show rehearsal, excluding load-in and load-out time, during our regular business hours (or to be arranged with our production assistant)

Marketing and Outreach

- we work with you to draft a press release or promotional flyer and provide support in sending information about your event to our media contacts
- we will include information about your event in our e-mail announcements to our list of over 3,500 subscribers
- we list your event and link to your web site from our web site

Fees Do Not Include Ticket Sales

- we can help with ticket pre-sales to your event online and at our box office prior to your performance for a service fee of \$2 per ticket sold
- we can provide box office staff (fees apply for box office staff at the rate of \$25/hr for a minimum of 3 hours—per performance)
