Our unique facility is located one block from the Lechmere T-station on the Green Line in a historic building with two exhibition spaces. Both spaces are available for fine arts exhibitons from all disciplines.

- no fee if accepted as an exhibiting artist, although we strongly encourage artists to become Multicultural Arts members.
- proposals accepted from both individuals and groups
- artists maintain 75% commission on artwork sold, with 25% going to support events/programs at the Multicultural Arts Center
- assistance with press and promotional efforts by our staff, including listing of events on all of our promotional materials (exhibition postcard, website, email newsletters, press release).

PROPOSALS

Please follow submission requirements listed below. Any incomplete proposals will not be considered. If your proposal is not selected, we do not discuss reasons for declining proposals. Mailed/emailed submissions considered only. We *do not* conduct interviews/in-person portfolio reviews.

With your proposal, please include:

- Statement of Purpose: Please include a brief description of your proposed project's content, what you intend for this project to accomplish and the timeline needed.
- Resume and/or Artist's Bio
- Examples of work: Accepted formats include slides, prints, photographs, cd, dvd, links to online photos or clips, etc.
- Return of materials: If you would like your materials to be returned to you, please include a self-addressed stamped envelope with your proposal
